## Teaching of Writing Program

The 12-credit, non-degree program in the Teaching of Writing has been honored as the University Continuing Education Association Mid-Atlantic Region's most effective and innovative credit program developed in 2007. Preparing certified teachers to enable students to become engaged proficient writers, the program focuses on theory and practice and embodies the core principles of the National Writing Project.

Participants complete 12 credits of graduate course work on the instruction of writing in addition to 20 professional development hours of workshops offered by NWP@Rutgers. Examples of Professional development are conferences, institutes, study groups, technology series and family-literacy seminars.

Program applicants must have at least five years teaching experience and hold a bachelors degree from an accredited college or university.
